COS AWARDS OF EXCELLENCE IN OPHTHALMIC RESEARCH POSTER AWARD CRITERIA

First place: \$2000; Second place: \$1500; Third place: \$750
Deadline for Submission: Tuesday, March 26, 2019 – 23:59 PM ET

To be considered for the award, you must submit your poster electronically by the submission deadline. Please review the criteria below carefully before submitting your poster. Late submissions will not be accepted.

PDF posters must be received before 23:59 PM ET Tuesday, March 26 to be eligible for the award.

POSTER CRITERIA

Criteria of eligibility to the award are all of the following:

1. To be considered for this award, eligible individuals must indicate their interest at the time of submission
2. The recipient must be enrolled in a masters or PhD program, or be a medical student, resident or ophthalmology fellow at a Canadian University at the time the work was conducted
3. One of the co-authors must be a COS member
4. The trainee must have completed the majority of the research project, i.e. be the first author, and the one presenting the work (supervisors will be contacted to confirm the level of participation)

Posters will be evaluated according to communicability, scientific communication and scientific merit/value. Judges will be looking for things like:

- Title and author names that are easily identifiable
- Innovative research, rigorous methods and conclusions supported by results
- Research question, background, methods, results, discussion and conclusion that are relevant, logical and linked to one another
- Engaging, clear and eye catching poster design
- Formatting that is appropriate and logical; graphs and tables are clear and easily visible
- Clear information that can be read in 3-4 minutes

The authors of the top three posters will give a simple 2-minute presentation to increase exposure of their work and facilitate discussion with meeting attendees. All presentations will take place during Current Concepts I on Friday, June 14.
